














The continuation of the war in Yemen resulted in an increase in the movement of internal displacement from conflict areas into safe governorates and areas. During January 2022, (1963 Households) (11813 individuals) were displaced. The governorates of Marib, Shabwah, Al Hudaydah and Taiz received (85%) of the displaced households were distributed across the governorates of Aden, Abyan, Al Dhale'e, Hadramawt, Al Mahrah, and Hajjah. Regarding the movement of IDPs departure, (228 households) (1202 individuals) left during January 2022. The movement of IDPs departure concentrated in the governorates of Al Hudaydah, Taiz, Marib, and Abyan.





Displacement tracking movement statistics indicate that (1963) households were displaced from 21 governorates. The displaced households from the governorates of Marib, Shabwah, Al Hudaydah, Taiz, Al Jawf, and Al Dhale'e formed (88%) while (12%) were displaced from the governorates of Dhamar, Raymah, Aden, Sa'adah, Amran, Al Mahwit, and Hajjah.
