
Displacement Tracking Report (DTR) For APRIL 2022

Apr 2022

The continuation of the war in Yemen resulted in an increase in the movement of internal displacement from conflict areas into safe governorates and areas. During April 2022, (479 Households) (2,896 individuals) were displaced. The governorates of Marib and Shabwah received (%58) of the displaced households, and The governorates of Ad Dali and Al Hodeidah received (%24) of the displaced households, while (%18) of the displaced households were distributed across the governorates of Aden, Abyan, Taiz, Lahj and Hadramawt.

Regarding the movement of IDPs departure, (49 households) (209 individuals) left the current governorates of displacement to new areas of displacement, or they returned to their areas of origin during April 2022. Most of the IDP HHs who left were from Abyan Governorate.

The statistics indicate that the households were displaced from 15 governorates. Forty-Five percent of the households were displaced from the governorates of Al Hodeidah and Marib, and (%32) HHs were displaced from the governorates of Taiz, Al Bayda and Ibb, while (%23) HHs were displaced from the governorates of Ad Dali, Al Bayda, Dhamar, Raymah, Shabwah, Amran, Sana'a, Sana'a city, Hajjah, Al Jawf and Al Mahwit.
