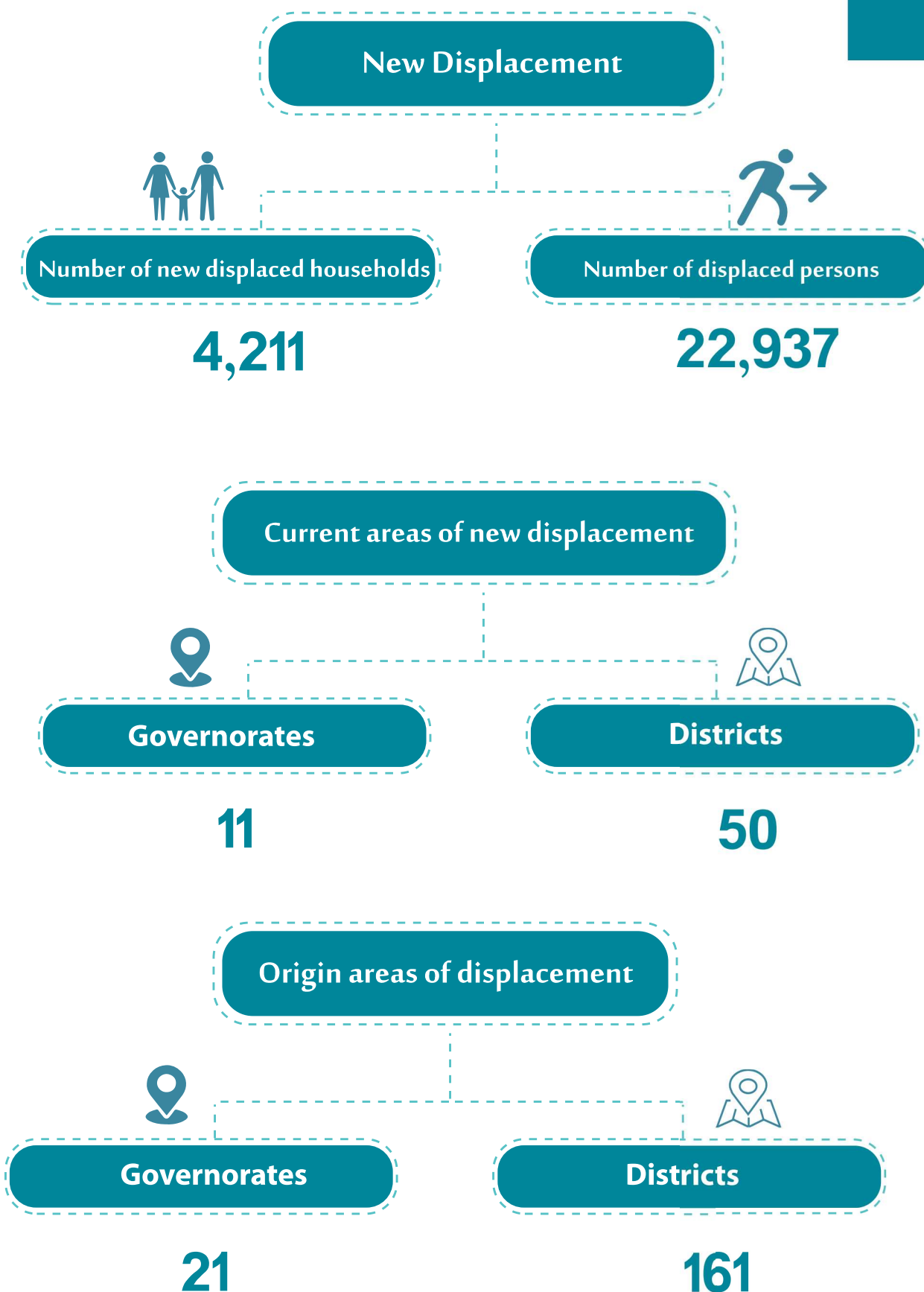

New Displacement Movement



New Displacement

During the first quarter of 2022, approximately (4,211 households) (22,937 individuals) were newly displaced. These households have been come from 21 governorates (161 districts) and they were received by 11 governorates (50 districts).

The main reasons for displacement:

- 1 - Armed conflict
 - 2 - Searching for livelihood opportunities
 - 3 - Violations and prosecutions
 - 4 - The spread of epidemics
 - 5 - Natural disasters
- And other reasons...

* **Internally displaced persons (IDPs)** : Persons or groups of persons who had to flee or to leave their homes or places of habitual residence, in particular as a result of or in order to avoid the effects of armed conflict, situations of violence, violations of human rights or natural disasters, and who have not crossed an internationally recognized state border.

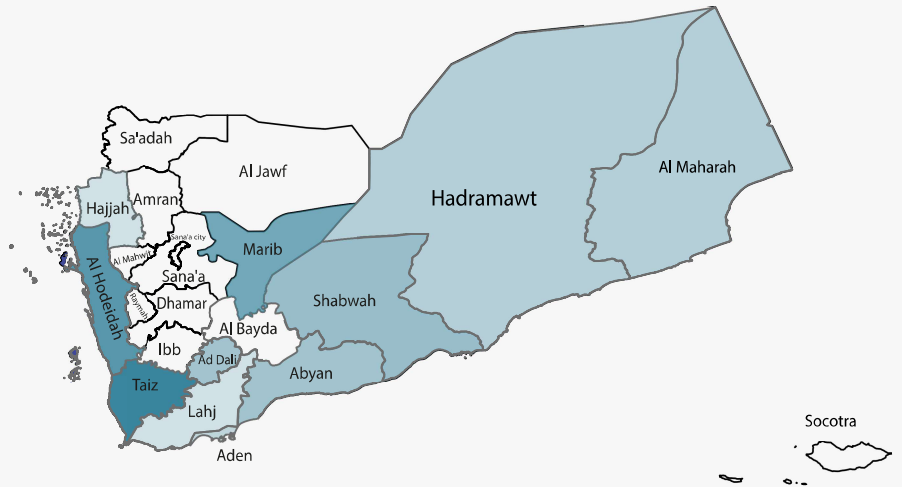


Current Areas of New Displacement

During the first quarter of 2022, it was recorded that nearly 11 governorates received the new displacement.

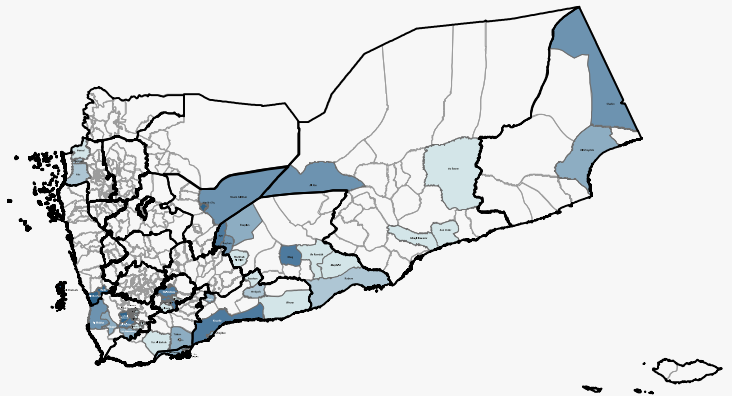

IDPs Departure

During the first quarter of 2022, approximately (251 households) (1,274 individuals) left their current locations of displacement. These households departed from 9 governorates (15 districts), and 13 governorates (40 districts) received them.

The main reasons for displacement:

1. Renewed armed conflict
2. Searching for better livelihood opportunities
3. Violations and prosecutions
4. Forced eviction
5. Desire to return home
6. Inability to pay rent
7. Fires and torrents
8. Diseases and epidemics
9. IDPs departed do not receive support from organizations.

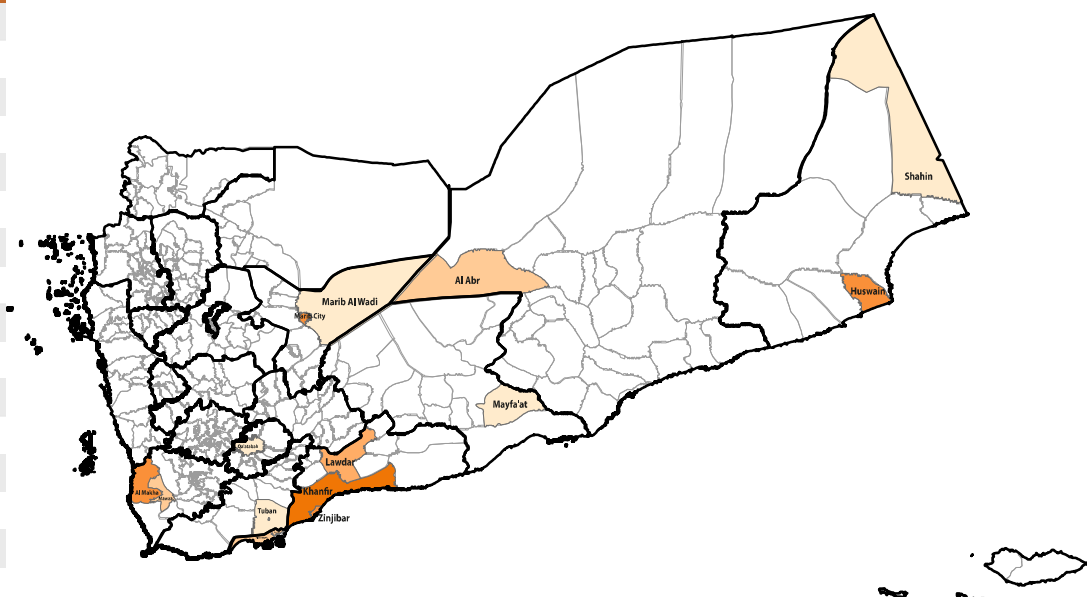

IDPs Mobility

During the first quarter of 2022, approximately (595 households) (3,756 individuals) moved within the same governorate. They include (300 households) (1,349 individuals) who moved from one district to another within the same governorate, while (295 households) (2,407 individuals) moved from one neighborhood to another or from one camp to another within the same district.

The main reasons for mobility:

1. The continuation of the armed conflict
2. Searching for livelihood opportunities
3. Violations and prosecution
4. Forced eviction
6. Inability to pay rent
7. Fires and torrents
8. Diseases and epidemics

And other reasons...

* **IDPs on the move:** They are the displaced persons who moved within the governorate of their current displacement from one district to another or between neighborhoods and camps of the same governorate.

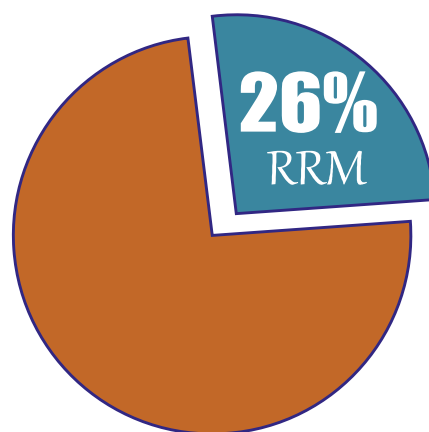


Rapid Response Mechanism (RRM)

During the first quarter of 2022, (01 January - 31 March), approximately (4,211 households) (22,937 individuals) were newly displaced.

This requires that all these households should receive many urgent and rapid interventions to meet their needs; this is one of the rights of the displaced persons. Such humanitarian interventions include various types, the simplest of them, for instance, is: Rapid Response Mechanism (RRM), It was reported that not more than (1,095) households, i.e. only 26% of the new displacement, received RRM.
