



## Khabb wa ash Sha'af Rain Damages-Al-Jawf

### Introduction

Khabb wa ash Sha'af District is the largest district in Al-Jawf Governorate but is the least densely populated. There are (3821) households with (27503) IDPs in the district. Alharag IDPs Site is located in Khabb wa ash Sha'af District and it was hit by heavy rainfall and the IDPs shelters were damaged.

### Incident Description

Heavy rain and wind storm hit Alharag IDPs Site on Wednesday 13/07/2022 and lasted for many hours leading to floods that damaged IDPs shelters, food items and NFIs. The following table shows the damages caused by rain and floods. No human casualties were reported. No intervention was reported until the moment of writing this report.

4. The local authorities should execute field visits to the affected sites to evaluate and provide assistance.
5. The local authorities should provide facilitate humanitarian partners, INGOs and NGOs access to the affected area

## Conclusion

Heavy rain floods hit Khabb wa ash Sha'af District in Al-Jawf Governorate on Wednesday 13/07/2022 and lasted for many hours and caused damage to IDPs shelters, food items and NFIs. (51) households were affected by the rain and floods. (51) shelters, (51) NFIs and (51) food items were damaged. No human casualties were reported. No intervention was reported until the moment of writing this report.
