#### Rainfall and Floods Affect Displaced Households in Shabwah IDPs Sites and Kills an IDP

### Introduction

Shabwah Governorate is one of the governorates that receive IDPs in IDPs sites. There are (17) IDPs sites in Shabwah Governorate. The number of IDPs in the governorate is (1066) households (6191) individuals.

## **Incident Description**

Heavy rain hit different parts of Shabwah Governorate on Thursday 04/08/2022 and lasted for many hours. The heavy rain hit Bayhan and Usaylan Districts and devastated IDPs shelters in (10) sites. The rainfall and floods affected (390) households in these (10) sites (223 households were affected partially while 167 households were affected completely). **An IDP was killed as he was washed away by floods in Dheba IDPs Site**. No intervention is reported until the moment of writing this report.

## **Damages**

# Recommendations

The following is recommended:

- 1. Quick response by humanitarian partners and NGOs to provide shelter, NFIs and food items to the affected households in the affected IDPs sites.
- 2. Joint cooperation and coordination between local authorities and NGOs to find safe lands for IDPs sites that are away from floods.
- 3. Providing early warning techniques for rainfall and floods that reduce the damages.
- 4. Raising awareness of the danger of rainfall in summer and how to prepare for rainfall especially in summer.
- 5. Local authorities should do their duty in providing assistance to the affected displaced households.
- 6. Local authorities should facilitate access of humanitarian partners to the affected areas.

# Conclusion

Heavy rain hit different parts of Shabwah Governorate on Thursday 04/08/2022 and lasted for many hours. The heavy rain hit Bayhan and Usaylan Districts and devastated IDPs shelters in (10) sites. The rainfall and floods affected (390) households in these (10) sites (223 households were affected partially while 167 households were affected completely). **An IDP was killed as he was washed away by floods in Dheba IDPs Site**. Humanitarian partners are strongly recommended to intervene quickly to mitigate IDPs sufferings.
