



Rainfall and floods Devastate IDPs Sites in Sayun District- Hadramout

Introduction

Sayun District is one of Hadramout Al-Wadi and the Sahara districts that lies in the central part of Hadramaut. There are hundreds of households in the district (most of them are Bedouins fled from Al Jawf Governorate) because of war.

Incident Description

Heavy rain hit different parts of Sayun District on Thursday 11/08/2022 and lasted for many hours. The heavy rain devastated IDPs shelters in the affected sites in Mariama IDPs Site, Madodah IDPs site and Alaidroos IDPs residential gathering. No human casualties were reported until the moment of writing this report. No intervention is reported until the moment of writing this report.

Damages

The rain and wind led to the damage of the following:

Recommendations

The following is recommended:

1. Quick response by humanitarian partners and NGOs to provide shelter, NFIs and food items to the affected households in the affected IDPs sites.
2. Joint cooperation and coordination between local authorities and NGOs to find safe lands for IDPs sites that are away from floods.
3. Providing early warning techniques for rainfall and floods that reduce the damages.
4. Raising awareness of the danger of rainfall in summer and how to prepare for rainfall especially in summer.
5. Local authorities should do their duty in providing assistance to the affected displaced households.
6. Local authorities should facilitate access of humanitarian partners to the affected areas.

Conclusion

Heavy rain hit different parts of Sayun District and affected IDPs sites on Thursday 11/08/2022. The heavy rain and floods affected (356) displaced households in damaging (134) shelters were damaged, (122) NFIs and (356) food items. No human casualties were reported. Humanitarian partners are strongly recommended to intervene quickly to mitigate IDPs sufferings.
