



Rainfall Causes damage in IDPs Shelters in AlGaran Alshamali- Hadramout

Introduction

Al Aabr District is one of Hadramout Al-Wadi and the Sahara districts that lies in the west of Hadramaut. It has a population of about 6000 and an area of 7764 km². AlGaran Alshamali is a Bedouin gathering in Alabr. It has a small population mostly (Bedouin). Currently, the district hosts thousands of IDPs. There are (1001) households with (4644) (most of them are Bedouins fled from Al Jawf Governorate) because of war.

Incident Description

Heavy rain hit different parts of Alabr District including AlGaran Alshamal IDPs Site on Friday 12/08/2022. The heavy rain devastated IDPs shelters, NFIs and food items in AlGaran Alshamal IDPs Site. No human casualties were reported until the moment of writing this report. No intervention is reported until the moment of writing this report. It is worth mentioning that AlGaran Alshamal IDPs Site was hit rainfall one month ago and caused damages in IDPs shelters and properties. the following table shows damages caused by rain fall and floods in IDPs sites. It is worth mentioning that this rain damage is the third within last few months.

Damages

The rain and wind led to the damage of the following:

Recommendations

The following is recommended:

1. Quick response by humanitarian partners and NGOs to provide shelter, NFIs and food items to the affected households in the affected IDPs sites.
2. Joint cooperation and coordination between local authorities and NGOs to find safe lands for IDPs sites that are away from floods.
3. Providing early warning techniques for rainfall and floods that reduce the damages.
4. Raising awareness of the danger of rainfall in summer and how to prepare for rainfall especially in summer.
5. Local authorities should do their duty in providing assistance to the affected displaced households.
6. Local authorities should facilitate access of humanitarian partners to the affected areas.

Conclusion

Heavy rain hit different parts of Alabr District including AlGaran Alshamal IDPs Site on Friday 12/08/2022 and affected (63) displaced households in damaging (63) shelters were damaged, (63) NFIs and (63) food items. No human casualties were reported. Humanitarian partners are strongly recommended to intervene quickly to mitigate IDPs sufferings. It is worth mentioning that this rain damage is the third within last few months.
