Rainfall and Flash Floods Destroy IDPs Shelters in Al Qahirah and Al Mudhaffer Districts - Taiz

Introduction

Districts of Al Qahirah and Al Mudhaffer are located in the center of Taiz Governorate. It is located in the south west of Yemen. There are IDPs sites and residential gatherings located in the districts.

Incident Description

Heavy rain and strong wind hit different parts of Al Qahirah and Al Mudhaffer Districts in Taiz Governorate on Thursday 04/05/2023. The rainfall lasted for many hours and generated floods that devastated residents' properties in nine sites. No human casualties were reported until the moment of writing this report. No intervention was reported until the moment. The following table shows damages caused by rain fall and floods.

Recommendations

The following is recommended:

- 1. Quick response by humanitarian partners and NGOs to provide shelter, NFIs and food items to the affected households in the affected IDPs sites.
- 2. Joint cooperation and coordination between local authorities and NGOs to find safe lands for IDPs sites that are away from floods.
- 3. Providing early warning techniques for rainfall and floods that reduce the damages.
- 4. Raising awareness of the danger of rainfall in summer and how to prepare for rainfall especially in summer.
- 5. Local authorities should do their duty in providing assistance to the affected displaced households.
- 6. Local authorities should facilitate access of humanitarian partners to the affected areas.

Conclusion

Heavy rain and strong wind hit different parts of Al Qahirah and Al Mudhaffer Districts in Taiz Governorate on Thursday 04/05/2023. The rainfall lasted for many hours and generated floods that devastated residents' properties in nine sites. The heavy rain and floods affected (182) displaced households in the nine sites in destroying (182) shelters were damaged, (182) NFIs and (179) food items. No human casualties were reported. Humanitarian partners are strongly recommended to intervene quickly to mitigate IDPs sufferings.
