Rainfall and Flash Floods Destroy IDP Shelters in Alsab'ateen (Alakesh) IDP Site – Al Hodeidah

Introduction

Alsab'ateen (Alakesh) IDP Site is one of the largest IDP sites Hays District, it is located in Al Hodeidah Governorate. There are (619) households with (3,678) individuals.

Incident Description

Heavy rain and strong wind hit Alsab'ateen (Alakesh) IDP Site in Hays District in Al Hodeidah Governorate on Tuesday 25/04/2023. The rainfall lasted for many hours and generated floods that devastated IDP shelters in the site. No human casualties were reported until the moment of writing this report. No intervention was reported until the moment. The following table shows damages caused by rain fall and floods.

Damages

The rain and wind led to the damage of the following:

Recommendations

The following is recommended:

- 1. Quick response by humanitarian partners and NGOs to provide shelter, NFIs and food items to the affected households in the affected IDPs sites.
- 2. Joint cooperation and coordination between local authorities and NGOs to find safe lands for IDPs sites that are away from floods.
- 3. Providing early warning techniques for rainfall and floods that reduce the damages.
- 4. Raising awareness of the danger of rainfall in summer and how to prepare for rainfall especially in summer.
- 5. Local authorities should do their duty in providing assistance to the affected displaced households.
- 6. Local authorities should facilitate access of humanitarian partners to the affected areas.

Conclusion

Heavy rain and strong wind hit Alsab'ateen (Alakesh) IDP Site in Hays District in Al Hodeidah Governorate on Tuesday 25/04/2023. The rainfall lasted for one hour and generated floods that devastated IDP shelters in the site. The heavy rain and floods affected (5) displaced households in the three sites in destroying (5) shelters were damaged, (5) NFIs and (5) food items. No human casualties were reported. Humanitarian partners are strongly recommended to intervene quickly to mitigate IDPs sufferings.
