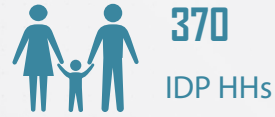


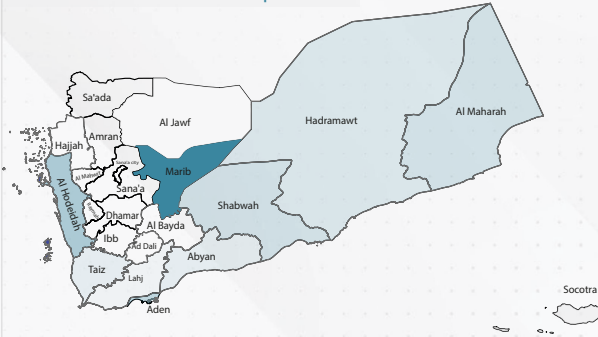
The continuation of the war in Yemen has led to increase the internal displacement from conflict areas to governorates and safe areas. During January 2024, (370 families) (1,986 individuals) were displaced from 17 governorates that displaced from Hodeidah about (32%), Taiz (20%) while bouth of Ibb and Marib were (11%) and (1.9%) distributed among the governorates of Sanaa, Dhamar, Amran, Hajjah, Al Bayda, Al Jawf and Al Mahwit.

With regard to the departure movement of the displaced, during January 2024 there is (15 families) (64 individuals) were left from the governorates of Aden.

The executive unit also tracked the returnees to their origin places and monitored (87 families) (412 individuals) during the month of January.



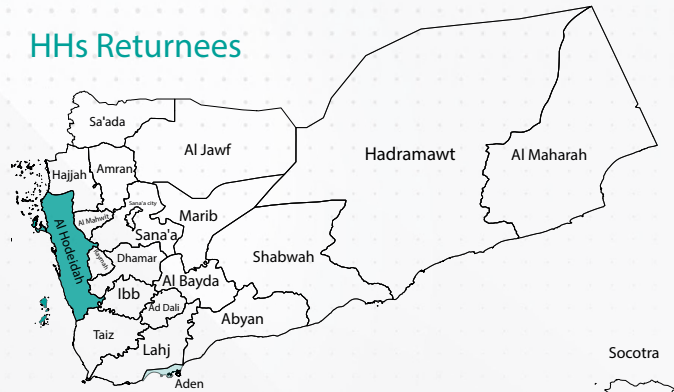
IDP HHs : Governorate of Displacement



IDP HHs Departed from Governorates

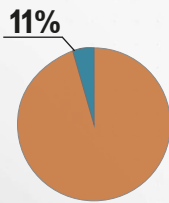
