Report on the Damage Caused by Heavy Rains and Flash Floods in IDP Camps in Khanfer District, Abyan Governorate





Introduction

Abyan Governorate exposed to devastated heavy rains, flash floods and strong winds on 16 - 17 August 2024, where 303 IDP HHs affected. The affected IDPs include: Kadmat La'our 44 HHs, Wadi Al Kud 69 HHs, and Al-Makhzan 20 HHs, An nash 20 and Jol Sinan and Jol Alsada 150 HHs in Jaar, Khanfar District. The heavy rains, floods and strong winds have resulted in the destruction of numerous houses, leaving households, including both displaced persons and members of the host communities, homeless and vulnerable. These households are in desperate need of food, shelter, NFIs and medical assistance.

Geographical scope

The geographical scope includes Khanfar District Abyan Governorate.

- Conducting field visits to the sites to register the affected displaced households.
- Assessing and evaluating the damages for affected households.
- Issuing an urgent appeal to the intervening parties in the governorate and philanthropists for urgent interventions

Interventions N/A (None)

Recommendations

- Rapid intervention of humanitarian partners to save the affected households.
- Call on the international community to help the government to confront the effects of climate change, build the capacity of the relevant authorities and create permanent and effective mechanisms to confront them.
- Joint cooperation between local authorities and non-governmental organizations to find solutions for safe sites and away from the flood stream of IDP camps.
- Strengthening the capacity of the executive unit by completing the equipping of the early warning center in order to reduce the effects of climate change on the displaced and confront possible waves of displacement.
